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## Infusion therapy methods

There are many different supplies used for infusion therapy. One of our pharmacists and your physician will work together to determine what IV treatment method best meets your needs:



### IV Push

- **Infusion time:** 3-10 minutes
- **Delivery method:** Pre-filled syringe



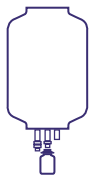
### Elastomeric Devices

- **Infusion time:** 30-120 minutes
- **Delivery method:** Small plastic container



### IV Pump

- **Infusion time:** Medication is infused frequently throughout the day
- **Delivery method:** Pump that can be carried in a provided pouch



### Gravity/Mini-Bag Plus

- **Infusion time:** Varies
- **Delivery method:** IV tubing with a dial to control flow (mini-bag plus is a vial of medicine attached to the IV bag to be mixed prior to use)
